“Green countries or territories”

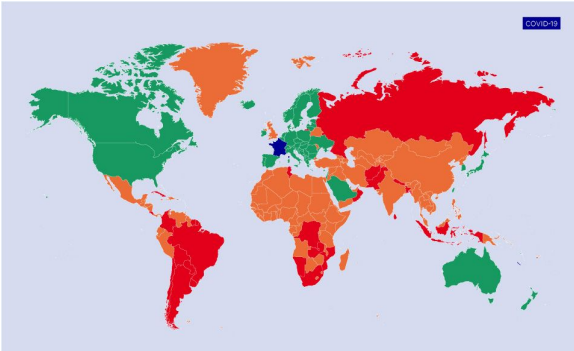
Countries where no active viral circulation has been reported and no relevant variants identified: European area countries, and Albania, Australia, Bosnia, Brunei, Canada, Hong-Kong, Israel, Japan, Kosovo, Lebanon, Montenegro, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Ukraine, the United States, Union of Comoros and Vanuatu.

“Amber countries or territories”

Countries where active viral circulation in controlled proportions has been reported, albeit with no spread of relevant variants. These include all countries not featured on the “green” and “red” lists.

“Red countries or territories”

Countries where active viral circulation has been reported, including relevant variants. These include the following countries: Afghanistan, Argentina, Bangladesh, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa-Rica, Cuba, Democratic Republic of Congo, Indonesia, Maldives, Mozambique, Namibia, Nepal, Oman, Pakistan, Paraguay, Russia, Seychelles, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Suriname, Tunisia, Uruguay and Zambia.

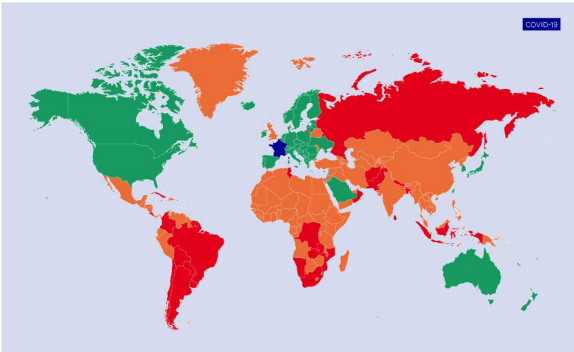
Vaccinated students

You must provide proof of full vaccination and a sworn declaration* certifying that you have no symptoms of Covid-19 and you have not been in contact with anyone with a confirmed case in the 14 days leading up to your departure.

The vaccination schedule is considered complete 28 days after the administration of a dose for Janssen vaccine and 7 days after administration of a second dose for other vaccines: Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Vaxzevria/Covishield.

Unvaccinated students

You must provide proof of a negative PCR or antigen test within the last 72 hours and a sworn declaration* certifying that you have no symptoms of Covid-19 and you have not been in contact with anyone with a confirmed case in the 14 days leading up to your departure.

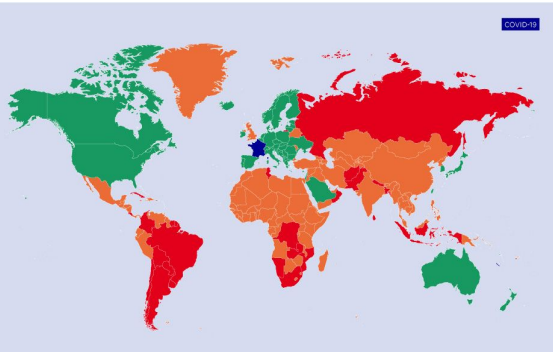
“Amber Countries”

Vaccinated students

You must provide:

- proof of full vaccination,
- proof of a negative PCR test within the last 72 hours or a negative antigen test within the last 48 hours,
- and a sworn declaration* certifying that you have no symptoms of Covid-19 and you have not been in contact with anyone with a confirmed case in the 14 days leading up to your departure.

The vaccination schedule is considered complete 28 days after the administration of a dose for Janssen vaccine and 7 days after administration of a second dose for other vaccines: Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca/Vaxzevria/Covishield.

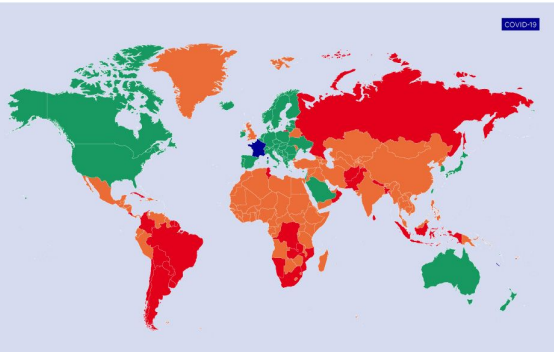

“Amber Countries”

Unvaccinated students

You must provide a compelling reason for coming to France and present the following when boarding:

- proof of a negative PCR test within the last 72 hours or a negative antigen test within the last 48 hours
- a sworn declaration* certifying that you have no symptoms of Covid-19 and you have not been in contact with anyone with Covid-19 within the past 14 days and you have agreed to undergo a screening test upon arrival.
This declaration also certifies that you agree to quarantine for 7 days after arriving and take a PCR test at the end of the quarantine period.
- an international travel certificate* indicating the compelling reason for travel, along with the supporting document: admission letter from ISIPCA for 2021-2022.

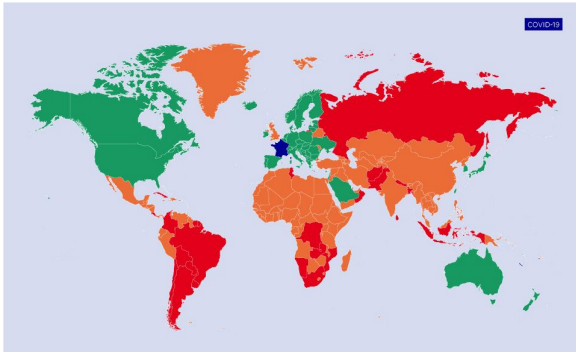

Submit your visa application

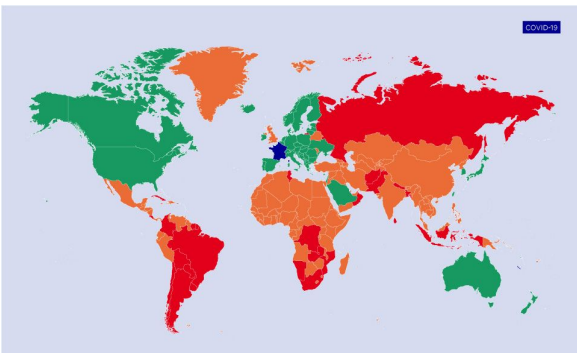
Borders are currently closed for international students from “red countries”.

But you are invited to submit your visa application. It will be examined by the French Consulate pending a favourable evolution.

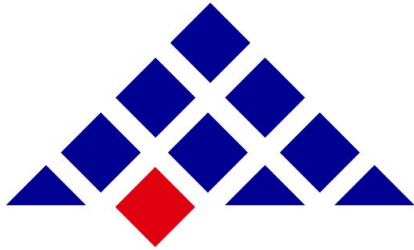
